

## PLAYWRIGHT ELIGIBILITY

- The playwright has had productions of their plays on Broadway, at major off-Broadway theaters, and/or at multiple LORT theaters, or other markers of attaining significant accomplishments and/or national attention as a playwright.
- The playwright is a citizen or resident of the United States.
- We welcome writers of all faiths, cultures, backgrounds, and racial and ethnic identities.

## PLAY ELIGIBILITY

- The play celebrates, explores, and/or struggles with the complexities and nuances of the Jewish experience
- We encourage plays which authentically represent characters and experiences of racially and ethnically diverse Jews, as well as explore the historic and present-day intersections of white Jews and Black, Indigenous, and Peoples of Color.
- The play is unproduced OR received a professional premiere no earlier than July 2018 OR is currently scheduled for its NYC premiere.
- The play is a complete, full-length work for the stage.
- The play is in English, either in composition or translation.
- Musicals and plays with music are eligible, as are adaptations that diverge substantially from the source material are eligible.
- Short plays and plays for young audiences are not eligible.

## AGENT OR ARTISTIC PROFESSIONAL SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- Submissions must be from agents or artistic staff members of professional theaters
- Submission must include the following information as attachments (or together in one attachment if you prefer):
  - Full script with playwright's name, pronouns, and contact information included on script.
  - Resume that demonstrates eligibility for the Prize.
- Please confirm in your email that the play you are submitting is either unproduced OR was produced no earlier than July 2019 OR is currently scheduled for its NYC premiere (and if so, where and when).
- All materials must be electronic files; either Adobe Reader (.pdf) file formats or Microsoft Word (.doc).
- Submission must be emailed to Theater J at [LitOffice@theaterj.org](mailto:LitOffice@theaterj.org) with the subject line "Vradenburg Submission."
- Submission deadline is April 1, 2022.
